Prof. Dr. Bhola Thapa as the Registrar

Rt. Hon'ble Chairman of Council of Ministers and Chancellor Mr. Khil Raj Regmi appointed Prof. Dr. Bhola Thapa as the Registrar of Kathmandu University on June 15, 2013 for a period of four years. Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Ram Kantha Makaju Shrestha recommended Prof. Thapa as the Registrar as per the University Act 1991.

Dr. Bhola Thapa is the Professor of Mechanical Engineering and has been serving as the Dean of School of Engineering since 2008. He joined the University in 1994 as a Lecturer.

Former Registrar Prof. Dr. Bhadra Man Tuladhar submitted his letter of separation from the post on June 13, 2013. Dr. Tuladhar is Life Member of Board of Trustee of KU.

Senate Meeting

The 64th senate meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Rt. Hon'ble Chairman of Council of Ministers and Chancellor Mr. Khil Raj Regmi at Singhadurbar, Kathmandu on July 5, 2013. Pro-Chancellor and the Minister for Education Mr. Madhav Prasad Poudel was also present on the occasion.

This was a budgetary session, which approved Rs. 2.35 billion annual budgets for 2070/71 Fiscal Year.

Welcoming the senate members, the Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Ram Kantha Makaju Shrestha said, "KU is vigorously moving ahead with addressing communities' need." He opined that the focus of the proposed budget was to take our programs into the community level. He also stated that KU has already set its mind to launch School of Law, its seventh School, and Mahatma Gandhi Studies Centre.

Newly appointed Registrar Prof. Dr. Bhola Thapa presented last year's audit report and also proposed annual budget for approval for the 2070/071 Fiscal Year. He stated that KU is planning to extend nearby lands of Hattiban premises

for School of Arts, procure lands for School of Education, construct new International Level Sports Complex at the University premises.

The main purpose of the visit was to expand international relationship of Kathmandu University with the various institutions and universities of Germany, Austria, Switzerland and the Netherlands.
